CONTEST RULES

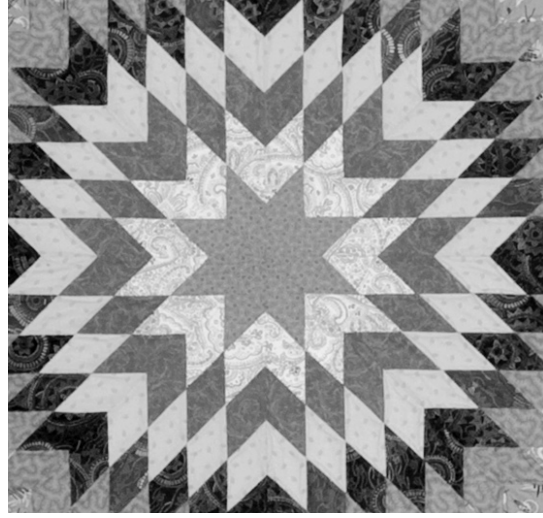
- ◆ Quilt Expo competition open to **ALL** quilt makers.
- ◆ All quilts will be juried; then judged by NQA Certified Judges.
- ◆ Quilts must have been made in the last five years and must not have been exhibited previous years at Quilt Expo.
- ◆ Each person/group may enter **one** quilt per category; maximum of **four** entries.
- ◆ All persons who stitched on the quilt, including the quilter, must be listed on entry form.
- ◆ All quilts must be quilted through 3 layers by hand or machine or both.
- ◆ Quilts must have a 4" deep rod pocket.
- ◆ Bed Quilts (categories 1-6) must be at least 60" to 90" wide and 80" or more in length.
- ◆ Wall Quilts (categories 7-10) must be at least 24" wide and 24" or more in length. Maximum size: 80" wide by 80" long.
- ◆ Quilts must be clean and in show condition.
- ◆ Quilts must be available from September 1-30, 2010.
- ◆ Each entry must include two 4" x 6" color photos printed on photo paper: one full view of the quilt hanging, showing all quilt edges and one close-up showing quilting details. Images will not be returned.
- ◆ Each entry requires a separate self-addressed stamped envelope for notification from the jury.
- ◆ Each entry requires a separate entry form and \$5 entry fee. Make checks payable to **Quilt Expo**. Cash not accepted.
- ◆ Entry form and photos must be postmarked by **June 25, 2010**.
- ◆ Quilts and/or persons who made them may be photographed and/or videotaped for promotional purposes.
- ◆ All decisions by the jury and judges are final. The jury reserves the right to reject or reclassify any entry.
- ◆ Quilts selected by the jury will be displayed at Quilt Expo September 9-11, 2010.
